

Guide for iPhone to establish Bluetooth connection with MS3398

Note: The version of iPhone should be higher than 3Gs in this document.

1. Check the name of MS3398 Bluetooth module

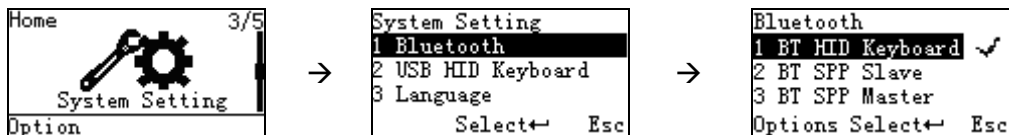
Check the name of MS3398 Bluetooth module by selecting **System Information**→**Bluetooth**. In the following example, the name is MS339850358.



2. Select the appropriate Bluetooth profile for MS3398

2.1. Make sure the Bluetooth module of MS3398 is powered on, i.e. the Blue LED on MS3398 is on.

2.2. Select the appropriate Bluetooth profile by setting **System Setting**→**Bluetooth**→**BT HID Keyboard**.



3. Guide for iPhone to establish Bluetooth connection with MS3398

3.1. Make sure the Bluetooth module of the iPhone is powered on.

3.2. Enable the iPhone to search the nearby Bluetooth devices. After a while, the name list of Bluetooth devices will be displayed on the screen.

3.3. Select the name of MS3398 Bluetooth module (e.g. “MS339850358” in this example) to establish a Bluetooth connection.

3.4 Make sure the languages applied for iPhone and MS3398 are the same.

3.5 Open a note on iPhone and scan a barcode by MS3398 to test the Bluetooth connection.
